





PROGRESS REVIEW 2014-2020

- 70 new students are enrolled each year







Faculty Development

- In service trainings for faculty were arranged









- Class Room Instruction and Learning Environment has been Improved

Proportion of students getting A+, A & B grades in HSSC




Proportion of Students Securing A+ and A grades in Class 9th



Proportion of Students Securing A+ and A grades in Class 10th




Outcome of the Project

100% are pursuing higher education after graduation from Al-Hijrah Distribution of Alumni Members in Various Fields of Specialization




Out of 312 total graduates, 108 (35%) have succeeded in completing their higher education while 203 (65%) are pursuing higher education in top educational institutes of the country.





■ The increase in the inintake and better retention, our alumni strength increased from 106 to 312 (194% increase)






Alumni On Job





Local Resources Mobilization

Since major operational expenses i.e. faculty and staff salaries, boarding, food, uniform and healthcare were sponsored by Turkiye Diyanet Vakfi; Al-Hijrah was able to mobilize local resources for the construction of 2 new dormitories/ hostels with capacity of 280 students, principal's family residence and expansion / improvement of Prayer Area.
